

## **ANNUAL WATER REPORT FOR 2013**

Hart-Ransom Union School is required by the State of California, through the Stanislaus County Department of Health, to provide students and parents with an annual report of drinking water quality. We are pleased to submit this report to you.

This report provides specific information on the quality of the water from the Hart-Ransom Union School system during the past year. The water supplied must be tested for compliance with standards set by the State of California and the Federal Government.

The chemical, physical and bacteriological attributes of the water are tested according to a schedule set by the above governmental bodies. The latest test dates are indicated in the report. Bacteriological testing for coliform bacteria is performed monthly. Other organic tests were run as required by the state, all tests were negative.

All test results are on file at the Maintenance, Operations & Transportation Office and are available for your review.
