

# HART-RANSOM UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT

## Transportation Services Plan 2022-23

Per Education Code (EC) Section 39800.1, as a condition of receiving apportionments for Transportation Services (under EC Section 41850.1), a local educational agency shall develop a plan describing the transportation services. The plan shall be presented and adopted by the governing board of the local educational agency on or before **APRIL 1, 2023** in an open meeting with the opportunity for in-person and remote public comment. The plan may provide for the local educational agency to partner with a municipally owned transit system to provide service pursuant to this section to middle school and high school pupils. Nothing in a local educational agency's plan shall preclude a local educational agency from providing no-cost transit passes to pupils.

Description: Hart Ransom Union School District currently provides home to school bus transportation for all students TK- 8th grade, including all qualified free and reduced students with onsite school buses serviced and inspected by a certified mechanic and certified to operate by CHP. Our special education students are also provided transportation by our normal operating services including pick up and drop off at prescribed and CHP approved bus stops listed on the school website and available through our district and school offices.

Description: The Hart Ransom Union School District currently provides home to school bus transportation to all pupils with disabilities, homeless children, and foster youth. All children being transported must be in the approved area's for bus stops that are within the districts transportation district boundary lines. The district also provides school bus transportation to students with disabilities through Storer Transportation Services.

Description: Hart Ransom Union School District currently and will continue to provide home to school transportation to the district's pupil population, be it children with disabilities, homeless children, foster youth, and unduplicated at no cost to the pupils or their families.
